



## **VIRTUAL ACTIVITIES**

Below are suggestions for various virtual fundraising activities that can be completed in place of typical in-person activities. Please do not hesitate to reach out if you have any questions, or need any help organizing these activities.

**VIRTUAL JAR OF CANDIES:** Fill a jar with candy and take a picture of it from all angles and send pictures to employees. Charge for each guess. The jar of candy is the prize for the closest guess.

**SUNGLASSES CONTEST:** Have employees take a selfie of themselves wearing their favorite pair of sunglasses. Have them submit their photos and then post somewhere where all employees can see the pictures. Have prizes for different categories. Employees vote with donations.

**BLURRED VISION:** Take photos of iconic images or landmarks around your office and blur the photos. Host a contest to see who can guess the most correctly.

**VIRTUAL BOOK CLUB** with \$10 dues.

**VIRTUAL BINGO:** It doesn't get any easier than Bingo. You can use a website like [My Free Bingo Cards](#) to play a traditional game with a virtual caller, or you can play a custom Bingo game that revolves around a movie or TV show that your group plans to watch. Don't forget to make small fun prizes, like an IOU for a cocktail or a gift card for takeout.

**VIRTUAL SCATTERGORIES:** Scattergories is a fun game to play with Zoomers of all ages. To play, head to this [free game generator](#) and send each person a link to the game. The rules are simple: there is one letter and five categories (things like "school supplies," "book title," and "girl's name"). You have 60 seconds to come up with a word that fits in each category and starts with the chosen letter. The more unique your answer is compared to your friends' answers, the more points you get.

**VIRTUAL SCAVENGER HUNT:** You set a list of items and have team members or individuals find them locally. Then they share a photo of the item. Here are some rules you may want to use for this timed event.

1. All items must be found on the premises; no leaving your location!
2. Each item can only be used once to fulfill an entry.
3. All photos or videos must be taken by the players—no screenshots, please!
4. Send all photos at once to avoid overwhelming the host with messages.
5. Any responses submitted after the time frame are ineligible.
6. Stay safe. At no point will the game require players to perform challenges that are dangerous or break the law.



**VIRTUAL 5K:** Charge an entry fee. Participants agree to run the same distance on the same day. Times are submitted to a designated person and the fastest time wins. Consider having age categories like an in-person 5k. Medals can be presented to all participants.

**VIRTUAL CHALK ART CONTEST:** Participants pay an entry fee. They create their masterpiece of chalk art on the sidewalks or in your parking lot. They take a picture of their entry and submit to designated site. Prizes are given for winners

**VIRTUAL BABY PHOTO CONTEST:** – Have employees send their baby photos to be included in a virtual document or presentation; charge a small amount for each entry and challenge team members to match the photos. Send a prize to the person who matches the most!

**VIRTUAL COLORING CONTEST:** Employees and or their children are given access to a picture to color. Decide on age groups for competition. Once page is colored have them take a picture of the completed page and submit for judging.
